The Walnut Creek School District has set February 5 – 15, 2018 as the time for the District's annual

KINDERGARTEN / TRANSITIONAL KINDERGARTEN PREREGISTRATION.

These early registrations help greatly in planning for class assignments.

Transitional Kindergarten

Parents of children born between September 2 and December 2, 2013, may register them for transitional kindergarten scheduled for the 2018-2019 school year. Registration will take place at the WUSD District Office, located at 960 Ygnacio Valley Road, Walnut Creek, CA 94596. For more information, contact the District Office at (925) 944-6850 ext 2000. Transitional Kindergarten Registration packets will be available for pickup at the District Office on January 29, 2018.

Kindergarten

Parents of children who are five years old on or before September 1, 2018, may register them for kindergarten classes scheduled for the 2018-2019 school year. Registration will take place at each of the District's five elementary schools. Registration packets will be available at the school sites beginning on January 29, 2018. A health examination report is recommended before school starts for the 2018-2019 school year and is required within three (3) months of entering first grade. This health exam can be scheduled as early as six (6) months before starting kindergarten or after February 28, 2018. A dental health prescreening is required by May 31, 2019 for transitional kindergarten or kindergarten students and may be scheduled as early as twelve months prior to the start of school. A doctor's name and telephone number and the name and telephone number of at least two people to contact during school hours if parents cannot be reached is needed to complete registration. RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS – Each family is required to submit valid proof of residency. Please review our residency requirements by following [this link](#)

A birth certificate or other legal evidence of date of birth must be presented at the time of registration. Also required are records of immunizations issued by a physician or registered nurse, stating the month, day, and year of each immunization, as follows:

Polio	4 doses at any age, but... 3 doses meet requirement if at least one dose was given on or after the 4 th birthday
Diphtheria, Tetanus and Pertussis	5 doses at any age, but... 4 doses meet requirement if at least one dose was on or after the 4 th birthday
Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)	2 doses , both on or after the 1 st birthday. Second dose must contain measles vaccine.
Hepatitis B	3 doses
Varicella (chicken pox) effective 7/1/01	1 dose or health care provider documented varicella disease or immunity.
