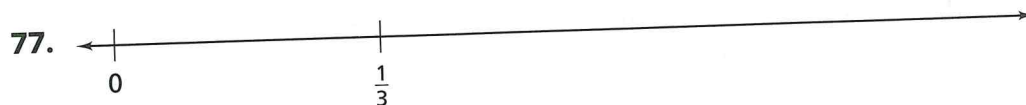
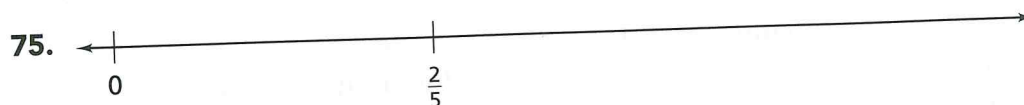




For Exercises 75–80, copy the number line. Estimate and mark where the number 1 belongs on each number line.

- Is it possible that Dario was sharing the pizzas with 11 other people? Explain.
